Word	Definition
	Article I, Section 8 of the U.S. Constitution that allows Congress to extend its delegated powers (implied powers).
	A system in which the powers of government are balanced among different branches so that each branch can check, or limit, the power of the other branches.
	The powers specifically named and assigned to the federal government (or prohibited to be exercised by the states).
	The distribution of political power among the branches of government, giving each branch a particular set of responsibilities.
	Powers not specifically granted to Congress by the U.S. Constitution that are suggested to be necessary to carry out the powers delegated to Congress under the Constitution.

Word	Definition
	The power of the U.S. President to choose members of his or her cabinet, ambassadors to other nations, and other officials in his or her administration.
	Laws made by Congress that people from other countries must follow in order to become legal citizens of the United States.
	A country's military forces.
	The presentation of formal charges on a government official of misconduct. (The act of impeaching.)
	The management of relationships and dealings between two countries.
